Reduce Plastic Use

Plastic bags are used for an average of 12 minutes, yet take more than 550 years to break down completely in a landfill. Reusable cloth bags are a great alternative to harmful plastic bags and are simple to store in cars, making sure you never need another plastic bag while shopping.
